

## Internet Explorer 9

The newest version of Internet Explorer is 9. It is available to Vista and Windows 7 users. For all you XP users upgrade your system and move into the 21<sup>st</sup> century. To begin with try the following to give you the feel and actions you have become used to:

1. Right click on the top bar on the page and a menu will open. Left click on Menu, Command and Status items listed. You will have to open this item three times for each selection. Once completed you will note new menus across the top and bottom of your browser. These menus allow you to make changes in settings and give you the feel of the older Internet Explorers.
2. Right click on the top bar again and remove any toolbars that have been checked. You don't need toolbars, other than those I have listed for any reason. These toolbars are simply other vendors way of keeping their name in view and of tracking your data, let your computer surf at high speed not at tell everyone I am here speed
3. When you visit a site and you enjoy it, make the most of it by clicking on favorites and then on Add To Favorites. Give the site a name. If you have a group of sites you want stored in the same folder, simply click on new Folder and give the folder a name. An example of this would be your financial sites you visit, you can set up a folder named Financials then you can save each site to the same folder. When clicking on favorites in the future, just click on the financials folder and then the link you have saved.
4. When adding to your favorites the newest ones always go to the bottom of the column. Every once in a while open favorites right click on any favorite and in the menu that opens left click on sort by name, this alphabetizes the entry's making them easier to find in the future.
